## Park Naming Contest

Heartland residents have a chance to leave their mark-Hillwood Communities & CCMC Management Company Staff have announced a contest to name two new parks in Heartland. The two winners will win 2 tickets each, to the Friday, April 20th Mavs vs. Golden State Warriors game, which also includes Platinum Parking passes. Park naming submissions are due no later than Friday, March 30th at 5 pm. Only Heartland residents may participate and multiple submissions are allowed. A committee of developer, staff and Resident Advisory members will pick the winners. Log onto the community website to submit your entry today.

**Park #1-** located at Sunnybrook & Blakehill. Amenities include a playground, multipurpose field, bike rack, trash containers, park bench, trees and landscaping.

**Park #2-**located at the end of Kickapoo. Amenities include 1/2 court basketball pad, pergola, picnic site with BBQ pit, shrubs, trees, landscape boulders, bridge, walking trail, bike rack, trash container, park bench and wrought iron fencing. This is a community build- project slated to break ground March 3rd.

## Volunteers Needed for Community Park Build Project Saturday, March 3rd at Kickapoo Park from 10 am-2 pm

The Resident Advisory Committee will be leading a Community Park Build Project on Saturday March 3rd. Located at the end of Kickapoo, this 4 acre site is naturally shaded, has an existing fishing pond and a stream from the overflow of the pond that dissects the park in half. The site is non-irrigated and will remain a passive park for everyone to enjoy. Hillwood is donating the time and resources for design and layout. We will also have the use of two front end loaders from a local vendor. Contact the Association office to add your name to the list of already 15+ community volunteers. Water and snacks will be provide to all volunteers. Please join us for this worthwhile community project.

Hillwood and CCMC Association Staff have worked with several vendors including History Maker to obtain the following materials and supplies:

- About 35 large to medium size boulders
- 50 basketball shaped and small sized rocks
- 23 large flagstones
- 1 adjustable basketball goal
- 1 20' x 20' pergola
- 25 assorted plants such as evergreens, Texas sage, box elder
- 8 panels of 8' x 6' wrought iron fencing
- Park bench
- Trash Container
- BBQ Pit
- Picnic Table
