Permit Submittal and Plan Review Procedures:

1. The Contractor will submit permit packet directly to Heartland Community Association with permit fee.

Permit Pack to include one each of the following:

- Permit application
- Approval form from the Heartland Community Association
- Permit Fees
- Site Plan stamped with approval from electric utility company to include distance from house and property lines.
- 2. Heartland will contact Bureau Veritas when the permit packet is ready for pickup.
- 3. Heartland will verify contractor license.
- 4. BUREAU VERTIAS will stamp the plans, issue the permit and return them to the applicant in a plastic bag. The bag must be at the job site for all inspections.

Heartland Residential Remodel/Addition

<u>What is an Addition</u> – Any construction work done to the main building that results in the addition of square footage to the footprint of the house. Additions could be carports, covered patios, sunroom, bedroom are any other room enclosed or open that is attached to the main structure.

<u>What is a Remodel</u> – Any interior or exterior construction work to the main structure such as moving walls, replacing windows, any major electrical, plumbing, and/or mechanical work.

What do I need to install a Deck? - Because they are not covered, decks are not considered additions to the footprint of the house nor do they have to meet setback requirements. Any deck 30 inches off the ground requires a permit. Submit a residential permit application and a drawing showing the house and where the deck is to be constructed. Include the materials to be used and a description of how the deck will be anchored to the ground.

<u>Do I need a permit for a Concrete Patio?</u> Concrete patios do not require a permit if they are not attached to the house foundation, however, if you plan to cover or enclose this area at a later date, a permit for the concrete is a good idea so we will have a record of the structural strength of the patio.

In-ground and Above ground Swimming Pools and Spas

Inspection Procedures:

1. Required inspections:

Belly Steel

Deck Steel

Gas Test (if applicable) / Existing Electric Changes

- 2. A four (4) foot temporary fence must be in place until the permanent fence is installed and inspected.
- The six (6) foot fence must be in place prior to the filling of the pool. 3.
- The common bonding grid installation can be completed at either the Belly 4. Steel or the Deck Steel, but must be visible for the Deck Steel inspection.
- Excavation material must be disposed to an approved location, and 5. streets/alleys/adjacent property must be kept free of mud & debris at all times. Do not block the alley or street with contractor vehicles.

Permit pack must be on site for all inspections

Residential: Electrical – Plumbing – Mechanical

Electrical Upgrades/ Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required for all service upgrades or circuit replacements.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

Plumbing Upgrades/ Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required when a gas line is added, replaced or repaired, installing gas logs inside your fireplace, replacing a gas or electric water heater, adding a water softener to your home or sprinkler system.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

Sprinkler Permits: An approved backflow device must be installed with each sprinkler system.

Mechanical Upgrades/ Repairs

When is a permit needed? A permit is required when an air conditioner or furnace is replaced.

What is needed to obtain a permit? A plan review is not required, but a permit fee is due upon permit issuance.

Submittal documents: Fill out a Residential permit application.

All Electrical, Plumbing, and Mechanical work described above require an inspection.
